

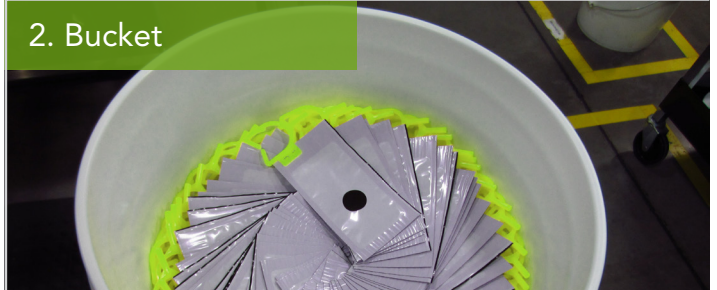
DEPLOYMENT GUIDE

1. Hang Pattern



- Determine your row pattern based on vine and row spacing chart (see diagram on next page)

2. Bucket



- Each bucket contains 1,000 dispensers which covers 4 acres

3. Pattern



- Begin hanging dispensers on the first row of the hang pattern
- Hung them at the cordon wire or the base of the canes

4. Placement



- Ensure dispensers are on a sturdy branch or wire on the shady side

5. Flow



- When the first row is complete, go to the second row of your hang pattern guide

6. Borders



- Use any extra dispensers to hang on borders or areas of high pest pressure
